Question One

Peter walks up to the bar and has an angry altercation with Milka. He grabs her arm and begins to drag her away but Musa intervenes, in the course of which Peter picks up a beer bottle and hits out at Musa. Musa ducks and the bottle hits Mary instead. The latter collapses in a heap.
